Q1. What is the stock symbol for Conexant, and where are the shares traded?

A1. The stock symbol for Conexant is “CNXT”, and the shares are traded on the NASDAQ Global Select Market exchange.

Q2. How can I get a copy of the latest quarterly report, annual report, and SEC filings?

A2. All annual reports, SEC filings, and the latest 10-K, 10-Q and quarterly reports are accessible from the home page of Conexant’s Investor Relations Web site, www.conexant.com/ir.

Q3. How do I transfer my stock, change my mailing address on my stock certificates, make other changes, or get other shareowner records information?

Q4. What is Conexant’s CUSIP number, and what is it used for?

A4. The stock certificate for each publicly traded company contains a nine-digit number called CUSIP, which is used to help facilitate the clearing and settlement of stock trades. Conexant’s CUSIP number is 207142100.

Q5. Can I purchase shares directly from Conexant?

A5. Conexant does not offer a direct purchase plan. However, you can purchase shares of Conexant stock from a stockbroker, bank, or other financial institution that provides brokerage services.

Q7. What is the date of Conexant’s fiscal year end?

A7. The fiscal year end for Conexant is September 30.



Q8. When will the company announce its quarterly earnings, and can I listen to the earnings conference call?

A8: The company issues a press release after the end of each quarter to announce the specific date and time of the earnings announcement and to offer details about how to participate in the earnings conference call. Q9. What accounting firm audits Conexant's financials?

A9. Deloitte & Touche LLP is the independent registered accounting firm that audits Conexant's financials.

Q10. Can you give a brief history of Conexant?

A10. Conexant was formed when Rockwell International Corporation spun off its Semiconductor Systems business in 1999 to create Conexant Systems, Inc. Through a series of acquisitions, mergers and spinoffs, Conexant emerged as a diversified semiconductor supplier. Today, Conexant is a leading provider of solutions for imaging, video, audio and Internet connectivity applications.

Q11: Can you describe the company's products and market segments?

A11. Conexant is a fabless semiconductor company with two major business units: Imaging and PC Media (IPM), and the Broadband Access (BBA).

The IPM business consists of semiconductor solutions for imaging, video, and audio applications, and is a well-established leader in analog modems that enable cost-effective Internet connectivity in products such as personal computers, television set-top boxes, and point-of-sales terminals.

The BBA business provides central office and customer premises equipment system solutions for xDSL networks worldwide.

A12. No. Conexant is a fabless semiconductor company, which means it does not own its own manufacturing fabrication facilities. Instead, Conexant uses foundries, which are manufacturing companies that produce semiconductors to Conexant's exact specifications.
